Eggs from a shop aren't/ are not as fresh as eggs from a farm.

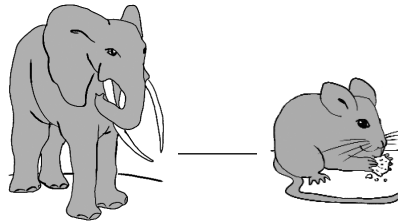
- b) big: Zurich - London
