Present Continuous (2)

- * To form the Present Continuous you take the correct form of "to be" and add "-ing" to the basic form of the verb.
 I'm playing./ You're working./ He's listening.
- * If a verb ends in "-e" you leave out the "-e" before adding "-ing".
 write → writing / have → having / hide → hiding
- * If the verb ends on a single consonant after a short, stressed vowel, you often duplicate the consonant.
 cut → cutting / stop → stopping/ forget → forgetting
